Western Lane Ambulance District Seeks Budget Committee Members

The Western Lane Ambulance District (WLAD) Board of Directors invite applications from residents interested in serving on the WLAD's Budget Committee. Interested persons should obtain an application from the SVFR station located at 2625 Highway 101, or from the WLAD web site: www.westernlaneambulance.com. Applications will be accepted until 5pm, Friday, March 15, 2019. After the review of applications, the WLAD Board will appoint members at their March 20 Joint Board meeting. Applicants must be registered voters residing within the WLAD district.

Since 1976, WLAD has provided Emergency Medial Services to the citizens and visitors of Western Lane County – an area encompassing approximately 1000 square miles of cities, towns, forests, beaches, sand dunes and other challenging terrain. The district employs 21 full time employees, 13 part-time employees, auxiliary volunteers, and Community Support Team Members.

The Budget Committee is a standing committee of five members that sits jointly with the WLAD Directors to publicly review and revise the annual budget. The Budget Committee approves the budget, permanent tax rate and local option levy. The budget then goes to the WLAD Board of Directors to be adopted.

Committee members serve three-year terms which expire on June 30. A Budget Committee Member is expected to spend up to 20 hours that includes reviewing the budget and meeting 1-3 times from April through June each year. The Committee may be called to meet again during the year in the event of a significant budgetary change.
